


What Is Keder?

Keder consists of two key parts: a cord and a fabric. The cord is made of extruded PVC and is then wrapped in a keder fabric. Our keder fabrics are designed with exposed fibers to allow our keder to more-easily slide into the keder rail. The flap of the keder can then be sewn to your material, or welded by heating the inner-lining of the keder.

To select the correct keder size, start by measuring the inside diameter of your keder rail or track. The diameter of your keder's cord should be 2-3 mm. smaller than your rail. For best results, ensure the keder is large enough to not pull through the rail's opening but is not too tight within the rail. When replacing keder, measure the outside diameter of your old keder's core.




Keder Cord Sizes

Our color-coded Keder Cord system makes selecting the right keder easy. Figure below shows the inner Keder Cord sizes.



Keder Fabric Types

Anti-Wick™	Features a unique weave that wicks away water (25 oz.)
Berry Compliant	Made in the U.S. — ideal for government projects (19 oz.)
HDP	High Density Polyester (HDP), low friction material (11 oz.)
Standard	Durable, reliable fabric that is translucent (15 oz.)
Panama	Tough fabric with a coating that blocks out light (19 oz.)
24 oz. Panama	Heavy, silver panama fabric that blocks out light (24 oz.)
32 oz. Panama	Heavy, white/white panama fabric that blocks out light (32 oz.)

Keder Flap Configurations

We offer custom manufacturing for all five of the configurations of keder flaps we make in-house. All of our keder is fully-bonded, a process that welds the keder fabric to its core from all sides, allowing it to endure wear significantly longer than our original keder.



Single Flap

Single Flap Keder has a single-side flap that can be sewn or welded to the fabric or material.



Double Flap

Double Flap Keder has two flaps that sandwich the fabric, then all three layers are sewn or welded together.



Welded Flap

Welded Flap Keder has two flaps welded together, to create a stronger single flap to sew the fabric or material to.



Repair Keder

Repair Flap Keder has a larger weld size and free flap to accommodate for damaged fabric/material for repair.




Double Keder

Double Keder has two keder PVC cords, welded in keder fabric, which can then connect two keder rails together.
